Finding Living People

ReferenceUSA indexes the contents of telephone white and yellow pages in the United States. The Business section is useful for locating businesses, associations, schools, and government agencies; it can be searched and sorted by name, type of business, city, and business size, SIC code, etc. The Residential section searches individual names, and may be used as a "reverse directory" to locate people by address and phone number.

SEARCH TIP: Use **U.S. Consumers/Lifestyles** NOT U.S. Standard White Pages

Heritage Quest Online has all U.S. Census records and an extensive City Directories and a map collection which is very helpful for identifying changing geographical boundaries. 28,000 full text history and genealogy books are included; selected Revolutionary War pension records and bounty land warrants; Freedman's Bank records, and the U.S. Serial Set.

Historic Newspapers

Find news articles covering many topics from hundreds of primary sources. Search using either the timeline or topic search to easily find news and eyewitness accounts and daily life in the colonies or during the Revolutionary War, westward expansion, the Civil War, Reconstruction, Industrialization, the Progressive Era, World War I, the Great Depression, Vietnam War, World War II, Civil Rights Movement, Cold War, globalization and other eras. Also included are illustrations, advertisements, classified ads, birth and marriage announcements, obituaries, stories about historic people and other articles exactly as they appeared in print.

Newspapers.com provides online access to 3,000+ historical newspapers dating from the early 1700s to the early 2000s, with full runs and portions of runs of well-known, regional and state titles to small local newspapers in the United States and other countries. It includes Santa Cruz papers.

The Santa Cruz Sentinel newspaper can only be searched at a Santa Cruz library including the branch libraries.

It provides detailed historical street maps that include building outlines, property boundaries, and natural features.
