Overview of 13 List Windows

Locating the List Window (13 of them)

- 1. *Lists* are found in the sidebars.
 - Right sidebar with drop down at top.
 - Left sidebar at the bottom click same as list on right.
- 2. List Windows are:
 - Entirely separate windows with their own special features.
 - Not all lists have list windows.
 - Many list windows are built as you access, so there may be spinning wheels.
- 3. Access to *List Windows* shows the lists that have windows.
 - Right sidebar (right) with drop down at top, use the orange rectangle at the bottom.
 - Left navbar (top section on the left) orange rectangle about the middle of the left side.
 - Command L.

Basic Operation

- 1. Features
 - Window is resizable, floats, and can be moved around (other sidebars are attached).
 - Number of items in this list is shown at top, number of marked people at bottom.
 - Has its own sidebar of lists that have windows same as on main page navbar.
 - The columns have titles of their contents (which can be changed).
 - Navigating double click to open family view for person.
 - Mark and unmark people.
 - Drag and drop to add a child, spouse, parent to a family.
- 2. Operation
 - Sorting within titles.
 - Click on a column title to sort it alphabetically or chronologically.
 - Click again to reverse sort; a small arrow shows the direction of the sort.
 - Some columns will not sort: Flags, Never Married Checked, Spouse Name, Parents, Ancestor/Descendant/Relative numbers, event memos, the combined "Birth-Death"
 - <u>Search boxes</u> in the upper right of the People, Couples, Sources, Places, Results, or Feasibility) List Windows.
 - <u>Edit in window</u> works in many of them. Click once, then click a second time (not a double click). Otherwise clicking opens the family view to make changes.
 - Columns add up to 12 columns/fields.
 - Number of columns is independent of other list windows.
 - Click column options button at the bottom (yellow grid) choose how many columns you want.
 - Resize width of columns click and drag just to the right of the blue up/down button (also Auto Size with *control click* of column title).
 - Choose fields in columns by clicking on the column content button at top of the column (blue w/up-down arrowheads). Hundreds of choices! Can also choose *None* or *Remove*.
 - Reorder columns click on column title and drag horizontally.
 - Multiple spouses if list is showing spouse name, a red arrow indicates more spouses. Click to see pop-up menu, listing all spouses, and go to family view to see more (works in List Windows for people, relatives, results, or calendar).
 - Children if list is showing # of children, arrow button appears; click shows each spouse and children with each, select a child to show in family view.

List Windows (13 of them)

.....

People – A scrolling, alphabetized list of all people in the family file.

- Can be searched and filtered to include only certain names.
- Can mark, unmark, sort, add columns, and search for anything on the list.

<u>Connections</u> – An automatically generated list of all the *Connections* you have made in your family file.

• Width is adjustable; columns can be sorted.

Sources – Lists all the source records for the entire family.

- Show/field, search box: choose fields; search for specific words.
- Columns can be sorted.
- Click once and then again to edit in place.
- Use Tool at bottom to set criteria.

Options

<u>Citations</u> – Shows a list of numbers (with details if present) pointing to sources.

• Builds a complete list of all citations and the fields where they are recorded.

Who: All people (722)

Citations for all people.

Include: All sources

- Choices at top.
- Update button at bottom.
- Can sort columns.
- No search box.
- All people> all sources rebuilds if you come back to this.
- Marked people>all sources (or other choices)
- Can look for duplicate use of sources

Events – Shows dates and places of occurrences in people's life.

- Can find people born in same year, born on same day, near each other, died near, buried
- May seem to open at nothing (based on previous settings)
- Use gear at bottom to set criteria

<u>Relatives</u> – Shows relatives of source person.

- Change source person at upper right.
- Column sort changes within each generation.
- Can add columns.
- Use gear to change settings.
- Suggestion: Mark relatives up to GG (see Calendar for idea).

Places – Opens geocode window (covered in June 2021).

- Gray arrows and blue arrows indicate places that you have geocoded.
- Search box use to find all events which use a certain place.
- Select a place to see list below of people using the event; double click to see their file.

Column

<u>Results</u> – Can show two types of *Find* results that you have already searched for – *Find* and *Advanced Find*.

- Drop-down at top of window lists recent searches.
- Repeats the search and builds the list.
- <u>Find</u> A generic search for a word or words in whole file.
 - Can't add or sort columns.
- Advanced Find performs multi-condition searches.
 - Can add and sort columns.

<u>Calendar</u> – Lists everything in file in chronological order according to columns.

- Can add and sort columns.
- Use gear at bottom to set criteria.
- Example all people born on same day, different years.
- Suggestion: Create a calendar mark relatives thru GG, X X X X X X Choose birth, marked people, all months. Put these dates in a calendar template, add pictures great way to remind family of family!

<u>Couples</u> – Lists all couples.

- Use search box to find people.
- Can add and sort columns.
- Idea Add column for # of children and reverse sort to see your prolific ancestors.

<u>Contacts</u> – A list of people you have entered, an address book.

- Can add and sort columns.
- Gear sets up criteria and updates list.

<u>Feasibility</u> – Warnings about dates that don't seem possible (covered in September 2021).

- Show box choose which people to list all, with warnings, marked, etc.
- Builds a list.
- Search box to find people within list, double click to see family view.
- Preferences at bottom to set up further criteria for the warnings.
