

Places: Mapping and Geo Coding in Reunion

What Is a GeoCode? It's the geographical coordinates of a place. Added with Reunion 10.

What Is a Place? It's the location of an event.

Autocomplete Place Names – shortcut for entering places, use drop-down list.

Repeat Last Used Place – Command “

Places Sidebar? (on the right through dropdown list, also accessed from left sidebar globe symbol)

Top Section used for

Searching in the Places Sidebar - begin typing to show list

Editing Names of Places

Double click to edit, click change (only affects places, does not affect change date)

If renamed in edit person window, geo code disappears

If renamed in places window, geo code not affected

Merging Places

Drag and drop

Rename place window appears

Does not affect changed date

Reverse Place Name Sort – puts items alphabetically according the last name in the entry (name after the last comma)

Bottom Section (when a location is highlighted)

Usage – shows all people who had an event in the selected place (can mark them), limit 7500, use share button to print complete list (indicate specific location)

Note – add notes (free form), geography, history, demographics, 2500 characters

Geo. – for geographic coordinates

Using Geo Codes in Reunion

Using the Geo Code Place

Window

Show places with no geo code
– which ones need to be done; work on at leisure

Never geo code button – for imprecise places (at home, near Atlanta)

Get - You can type in a geo code for a place (decimal w/space betw/lat & long)

Use GET button to find a geo code

(Choose Google or Bing in settings gear, Bing doesn't support multiple mapping)

Accessing Geo Code Place Window (three ways)

At the bottom of the place list window

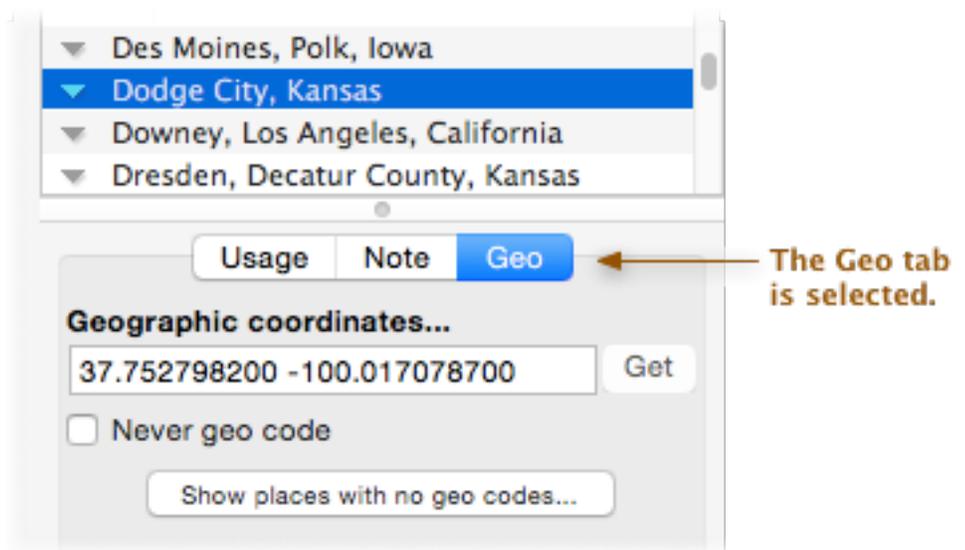
Or click triangle next to place name in the place list or in the person's events page

Choose *Map this place*

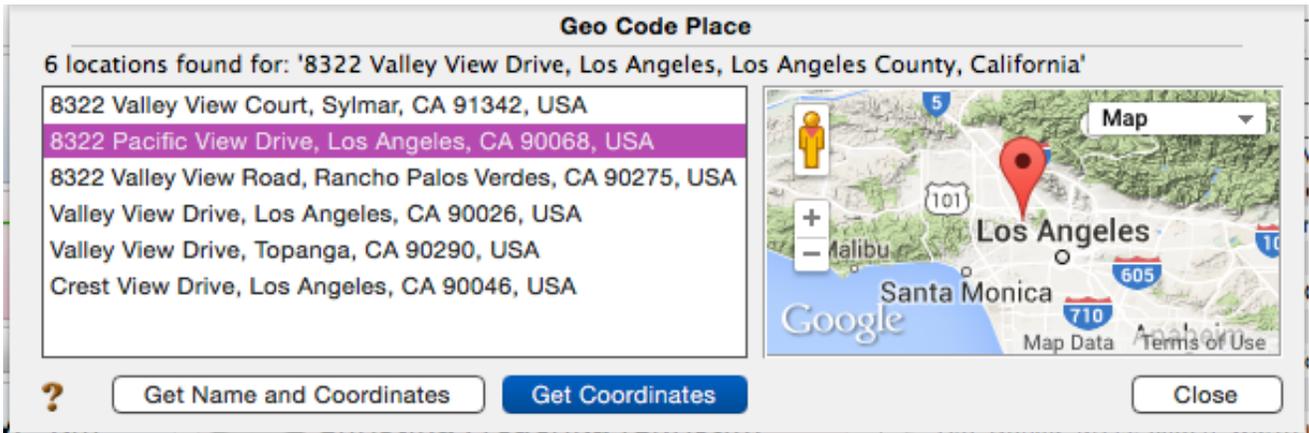
Will open Google or Bing

If not blue, will try to find the place based on the text

If blue, will open Google or Bing and pinpoint place on map



Bottom of the Places sidebar.



Geo Code Place Window will show

- List of possible matches
- A map (zoomable)
- Get name & coordinates – uses Google’s formatting (don’t choose?)
- Get coordinates – shows only the coordinates, keeps your spelling
- Close – take no action

Get (at bottom of list view in sidebar) You can get your own geocode and type it in
 Reunion uses a decimal w/space or comma betw/lat & long)

Limited to 150 per day

Decimal degrees are located in the URL of Google maps after the @

Or Control Click on the red pin and choose *What’s here?* to see geocode.

Pinpoint exact location

Move the pin – a home, a cemetery, a farm

Then retrieve the geo coordinates of the moved pinpoint

(Zoom to get more precise, then click Get Coordinates)

Assigning Geo Codes for All Places

In Places List, select geo tab at bottom

Click Show places w/no geo codes

Opens Geo Code Multiple Places window w/list of all places w/out geo code

As you click on a place, potential matches will show

Choose a match or skip

Skip has same effect as never geo code

Mapping Multiple Places

Click triangle on person button or in edit window

Choose Map all places for this person

Only works for places that have geo codes

When map is created, clicking on a pin point shows info

Multiple places can’t be mapped for multiple people (currently)
