Recording Military Service

1. Information from widow's pension for WWI at **Ancestry** (Pension Application, Image 11) – info is toward the bottom <https://search.ancestry.com/search/db.aspx?dbid=1677>
2. Show Soldiers, Sailors (William Williams, Confed, 27 infantry) – affirms pension info
3. Show example image WWWilliams Muster Roll, p 2

Ways to add information about military service or muster roll:

1. **In Notes** - incorporate in Miscellaneous Notes or add Military Note (Fold3)
(W W Williams, Private, Co B, 27 Regt Alabama Infantry, Muster Roll; Paroled in accordance with the terms of a Military Convention entered into on the 26th day of April, 1865, between General Joseph E Johnston, commanding Confederate Army, and Major General W T Sherman, Commanding United States Army in North Carolina. Roll dated 28 Apr 1865. Paroled at Greensboro, NC, May 1, 1865. Marked present.)
2. **In Facts** – create new fact using preferences (27th Alabama, Co B)
3. **Name** – add military title (Private)
4. View: Ben Sayer 2011 <http://genealogytools.com/preserving-muster-events-in-reunion-for-mac/>
In Events – for dated events – create new event using preferences (1 May 1865, Greensboro, North Carolina, paroled)

Don't forget to add the source.



Adding Information to Images in Preview and Photos: Markup



Examples:

SCAN0019 (picture of my mother and her sister, not marked up)

Jane and Virginia (same picture, with “Jane and Virginia” added)

North Carolina Land Grants, Book 1 (with source information added)

Example: Probate Folder

William Guinn Williams – **FamilySearch**>Catalog>Alabama, Marshall + keyword Estate>Probate Records>Alabama Estate Files, 1830-1900 (online) >William Williams, Marshall>Estate Records, Marshall County (folder cover)

Where to find citation information:

FamilySearch (at bottom of page; use copy citation button)

Download image and markup

Markup directions for Preview

Open the image/picture in Preview

Make a copy of the picture – always work from a copy, keep the original unchanged

Open Markup Toolbar – the suitcase by the search box

Choose font attributes

Choose Text Box

Paste info copied from Family/Search; adjust as necessary

Markup directions for Photos

First make a copy of the image – Image>duplicate


Open Edit Photo in right sidebar

Open Extensions at bottom right

Open Markup – it shows along the left top (this is very dark; hover over the area and text identifying the functions will show)
