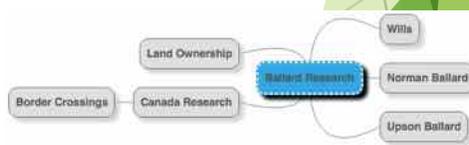

Why a research plan?

- ▶ Searching vs. Researching
- ▶ Tracking results
- ▶ No duplication of work
- ▶ Creates focus for your work
- ▶ Helps define an exhaustive search
- ▶ Helps with genealogical proof standard (GPS)

Why Mind mapping

- ▶ Brainstorming
- ▶ Generating ideas for where to look
- ▶ Easy visualization
- ▶ Sparks other ideas
- ▶ Easy way to jot down all ideas
- ▶ Online options
- ▶ Offline options
- ▶ Free options



Generating the plan

- ▶ What question to ask?
 - ▶ Broad questions
 - ▶ **Specific questions**
- ▶ What is known
- ▶ Where to look for information
 - ▶ Online/Offline
 - ▶ Local/Remote
 - ▶ Detailed plan

Who were his parents?

What's his birthdate?

Where was he born?

What were JU Ballards parents' names?

Define where to look for information - Online

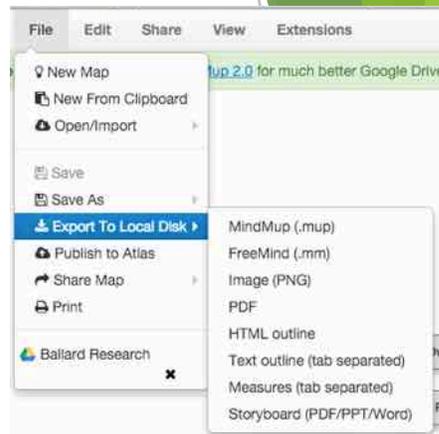
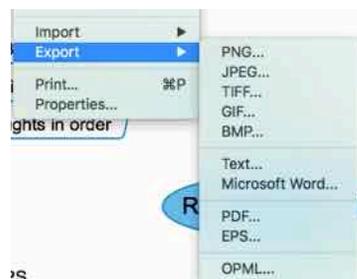
- ▶ Ancestry
- ▶ FamilySearch
- ▶ My Heritage
- ▶ Find My Past
- ▶ Fold3
- ▶ Define what sites you need to visit based on question - grave websites? County websites? Land websites?
- ▶ Document your sources!

Define where to look for more information

- ▶ Local resources/repositories
 - ▶ Hours/Access
 - ▶ Camera/Scanning capabilities
 - ▶ Document your sources!
- ▶ Remote resources
 - ▶ E-mailing/Website
 - ▶ Writing/Calling
 - ▶ Patience & waiting for a response

Transferring the Mindmap

- ▶ Exporting options
 - ▶ Check the program - what files can you export to?
 - ▶ BMP, GIF, HTML, JPEG, PDF, PNG, TIFF
 - ▶ Text, Word, PPT
 - ▶ Excel, MS Project



Using it in Reunion

- ▶ Adding it to logs
 - ▶ Use when exporting the research plan to text
 - ▶ Generate a plan per question
 - ▶ Copy & paste into Reunion
 - ▶ Use a Calendar program to setup reminders
 - ▶ Follow-up on research requests
 - ▶ Gmail, iCal, Outlook
 - ▶ Document who you contacted and when
 - ▶ Document when to follow-up
 - ▶ Document your sources!

Using it in Reunion

- ▶ Adding it to notes
 - ▶ Notes are on a per person or per family basis
 - ▶ Add completed research to each person
 - ▶ Make sure to document sources!
 - ▶ Document what was found and transcribe as needed
 - ▶ Once plan is complete - review added information, did it answer the question?
